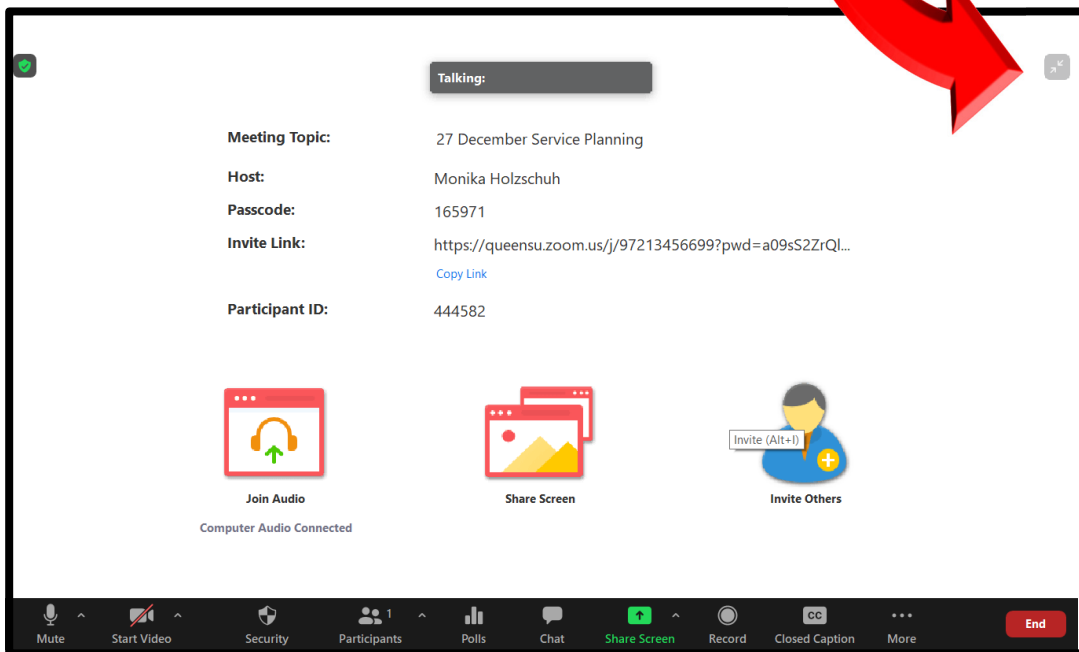


Worshipping together over Zoom

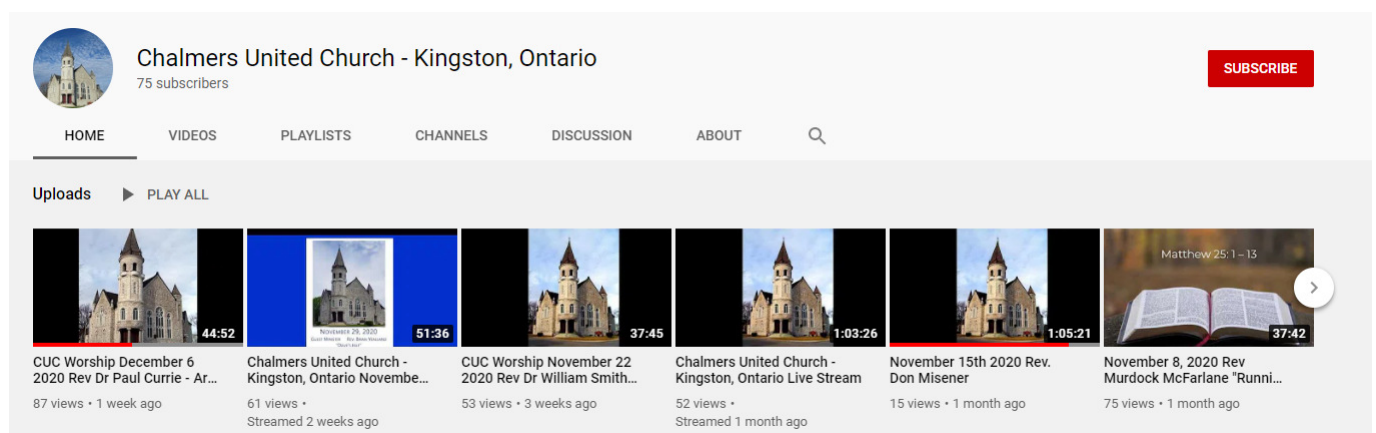
This is possible when you go to the Chalmers Youtube website and share your screen with others on your zoom call.

Start by exiting full screen by clicking on the arrows in the top right corner of your zoom screen.



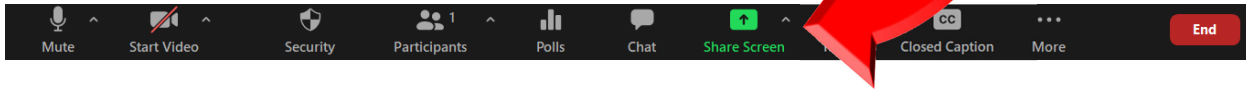
Now go to your browser and open the Chalmers You Tube site:

Open the service you would like to attend and pause it, then go back to zoom.

Share the service with others by clicking the green 'Share Screen' on the ribbon at the bottom of your screen.

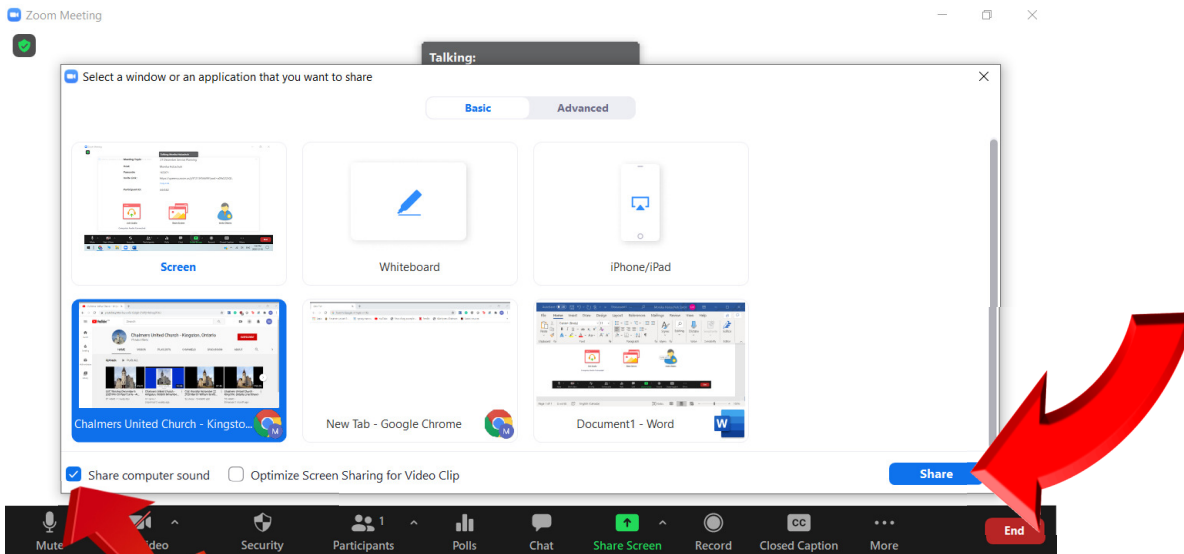


When you click 'Share Screen', a window opens that allows you to choose which screen you would like to share.

Here, just the Chalmers screen has been chosen and is now highlighted in blue.

[Tip: You can also click on 'Screen' just above that, and the other persons on the zoom call will be able to follow wherever you are going on your device. This is not needed here.]

Before you click the blue 'Share' button below,



be sure that 'Share computer sound' in the left bottom corner is checked, so that your computer sound is shared with others in your zoom call.

No go back to the Chalmers website and start your service. Everyone should be able to follow along together.

Play with the photo display – if you choose Gallery view, you should be able to see everyone as well!

[Technical Extra: Normally, only the person who initiated the zoom call can share their screen.

If you would like others to share, too, click on the arrow to the right of the 'share screen' icon, and choose: Multiple participants can share simultaneously.

You do not need this function for sharing the service, but it might be handy for sharing photos etc. later.]
